S/N	Question	Answer
1.	Do I need to take an antigen rapid test (ART) to visit AVENUE Lounge?	Yes. AVENUE Lounge adheres to prevailing safe management measures for nightlife venues. All guests must meet the following criteria: (i) They must be either fully vaccinated, or have recovered from Covid-19 in the past 180 days, or be medically ineligible for Covid-19 vaccination; and (ii) They must take an antigen rapid test (ART) supervised by an MOH-approved test provider and obtain a valid negative test result
2.	AVENUE is a bar, not a nightclub. Why do I still need to take an ART?	Both AVENUE and MARQUEE are venues which fall under prevailing safe management measures outlined for the nightlife sector. Therefore, all visitors to AVENUE or MARQUEE must take a supervised ART and have a valid negative test result.
3.	How long does it take for the ART result to show on my TraceTogether app?	You should be able to view your test result in the Home Screen under the COVID Health Status section of your TraceTogether (TT) App, or via HealthHub shortly after completion of your ART. Please ensure that the test result is uploaded to your app before heading down to AVENUE.
4.	How much time should I factor to take my ART and head down to AVENUE?	Each ART is valid for 24 hours from the time of testing. Your supervised ART must be valid until closing time (6am).
5.	Do I have to pay for the ART?	Yes, guests will have to pay for the COVID-19 test(s) as part of ART requirement, at their own cost.

		<p>ART can be performed on-site at Marina Bay Sands without prior appointment. The testing facility is located at L1, Sands Expo & Convention Centre and is open from 1100-1900hrs daily. Each ART, administered by Dr Anywhere, in Marina Bay Sands costs S\$30.</p> <p>Alternatively, you can opt to take your ART at any other MOH-approved Covid-19 test provider. The full list of test providers can be found here.</p>
6.	<p>I have been fully vaccinated overseas. Does this mean I can be exempt from ART?</p>	<p>No, all guests visiting AVENUE must be fully vaccinated (or exempted from Vaccination-Differentiated Safe Management Measures) and have a valid negative ART result.</p> <p>Please note that guests who have been vaccinated overseas must have their vaccination records updated in Singapore's National Immunisation Registry. Vaccinated travellers (short-term visitors) who are flying into Singapore and intend to visit AVENUE must be able to show a fully vaccinated status in the TraceTogether App.</p> <p>More details can be found on the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority website or the Ministry of Health's (MOH) Post Vaccination Matters.</p>
7.	<p>How long are the COVID-19 test results valid for?</p>	<p>The validity of your COVID-19 Test Result Notice is 24 hours from the time of testing.</p> <p>You must not enter or remain in AVENUE beyond the validity period stated on your COVID-19 Test Result Notice.</p> <p>As such, you must get tested:</p> <p>(i) Before the start of your visit; and</p>

		<p>(ii) A maximum of 24 hours before the end of your activity/visit to AVENUE.</p> <p>Kindly note AVENUE will only allow entry for guests who have a supervised ART result which is valid till closing time (6am).</p>
8.	What are the operating hours for AVENUE?	AVENUE will operate on Fridays and Saturdays from 10pm till late.
9.	Will food and alcoholic beverages be available till closing time?	Food and alcoholic beverages will be available till closing time.
10.	What do I need to present for entry?	<p>Guests must bring along the following items:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A working TraceTogether (TT) Token or updated TT app 2. A mobile device that has call and internet service to access your test results and vaccination status 3. Original Government-issued photo identification for verification purposes (e.g. NRIC, FIN, Passport) 4. COVID-19 Test Result Notice <p>*Please note that ART checks will be verified via the TraceTogether app/token or Healthhub app, or with hard copy result slip for ART. Please refer to https://www-moh-gov-sg-admin.cwp.sg/docs/librariesprovider5/pre-event-testing/acceptable-document---28-feb-2022.pdf for the acceptable documents for entry. Screenshots or photographs of ART results or vaccination certificates will not be accepted.</p>
11.	Do I still need to wear a mask and observe safe distancing if I have a valid negative ART result and am fully vaccinated?	Yes. All guests are required to adhere to the prevailing Government safe management measures, such as mask-wearing except when eating and drinking, to reduce the risk of community spread. Intermingling with individuals from other social groups is not permitted. Safe distancing of at least 1 metre is required for mask-off settings.

12.	Can I use an Antigen Rapid Test (ART) Self-Test Kit?	No. According to Government guidelines, self-administered Antigen Rapid Tests will not be recognised. The ART must be supervised by an MOH- approved Covid-19 test provider. You may refer to Go.gov.sg/swabproviders for the list of approved MOH Covid-19 test providers.
13.	Will you accept Supervised ART (Tele-ART) results?	Yes, we accept supervised ART (Tele-ART) results, which must be uploaded to the TraceTogether app/token or HealthHub app for verification.
14.	I am not vaccinated, but I have recently recovered from COVID-19 within the past 180 days and have a valid PET Exemption Notice/Discharge memo stating the PET exemption period. Can I still visit AVENUE without an ART?	No, all attendees must have a valid negative ART result. Please refer to https://www-moh-gov-sg-admin.cwp.sg/docs/librariesprovider5/pre-event-testing/acceptable-document---28-feb-2022.pdf for the documents to produce for entry.
15.	I am medically ineligible for Covid-19 vaccination, can I still visit AVENUE?	Yes, guests who are medically ineligible* to undergo Covid-19 vaccination may visit AVENUE, provided they have a valid negative ART result. * To be certified as medically ineligible for all COVID-19 vaccines under the National Vaccination Programme, individuals may visit a doctor familiar with their medical condition, or alternatively, any clinic or hospital to obtain a hardcopy doctor-certified memo.
16.	What happens if I have a positive or invalid ART result?	You will not be permitted entry with a positive or unclear test result from your ART.
17.	Does AVENUE adhere to vaccination-differentiated safe management measures?	Yes, VDS rules apply for entry to AVENUE. In addition, all guests are required to have a valid negative ART result.
18.	Are there any age restrictions?	AVENUE welcomes all guests aged 21 and above.

19.	Will all the arcade games, bowling alley and pool table be available for use by guests?	The arcade games, bowling alley and pool table will be available for guests' use, subject to prevailing safe management measures.
20.	Will your karaoke room be open for booking?	In the initial re-opening phase, karaoke facilities will not be available to guests. However, the private room will still be available for guests to book.
21.	Do I need to make a reservation to visit AVENUE or are you accepting walk-in guests?	<p>AVENUE is only accepting VIP table reservations, in groups of up to 10 persons. We are unfortunately not able to accept walk-in guests.</p> <p>Kindly e-mail avenue.reservations@marinabaysands.com or call +65 6688 8680 for enquiries or reservations.</p>
22.	What are the hygiene and safety measures for attendees, staff and performers?	<p>Marina Bay Sands has implemented several safety and hygiene measures at AVENUE so that nightlife can resume in a safe and responsible manner.</p> <p>AVENUE is a SG Clean-certified venue and has stepped up the frequency of cleaning and disinfection of all common areas and high-touch surfaces.</p> <p>The venue has procedures in place to ensure compliance with the Safe Management Measures</p> <p>Aside from mandatory SafeEntry check-in via the TraceTogether app or Token, trained Safe Distancing Ambassadors will be deployed to ensure the measures are adhered to.</p> <p>For more information on AVENUE's safety and hygiene measures, click here.</p>
